2. Pastor/Principal Reports/Comments – *Mrs Scaramucci* Most staff will be at Sip and Shop this weekend. The proceeds from Sip and Shop will go to technology upgrade. For all new computers in computer lab, laptops for teachers, and hardware server upgrades is about \$50,000. Dress down money, money from Auction and Sip and Shop will all go to technology upgrades. Marketing for Auction: There are ideas to break down for what smaller increments of money could buy. The auction typically brings in \$30-35,000. There was a question about buying new ipads. Ipads are newer and not used as frequently as teacher laptops. \$13,000 for teacher laptops, \$18,000 for computer lab upgrades, and 18,000 for network updates. Next Thursday is the Christmas Concert. The schedule: K-5 each sing a song, band, intermission, and then play. Connie Fletcher is the website person and will be taking over the Bulletin. Open House is January 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> to kick off Catholic School's Week. During Catholic School's Week: Nelson's Wildlife, service projects are Villa Marie and a collection for Most Holy Trinity School in Corktown, students vs staff volleyball game, Mrs. Scaramucci will take one 7<sup>th</sup> grader and one 8<sup>th</sup> grader to Academic Olympics at Cabrini, and living artist museum. End of quarter is two weeks into January. Star testing for winter is in January. Social Studies curriculum: met with 4-8 and 3-8; new social studies textbooks/curriculum 4-8 for next school year.
