- No fake/exaggerated body parts
- No tight clothing/bare leggings; leggings must have shorts over them.
- No costumes or accessories that make noise or have sound effects
- Inflated costumes must be deflated once school starts and remain that way in classrooms and in the hallways

#### 2. Before coming to school (things to do a*home*)

- Put on your costume
- Apply your make-up
- Color your hair, if necessary

#### 3. At school

- Students need to be able to manage their own costumes throughout the day.
- Make-up is not to be applied at school
- No colored hair spray may be brought to school
- No pranks
- Show your school spirit by participating appropriately and having fun.
- Making fun of another student's costume will not be tolerated nor will costumes that mock or make fun of someone at the school.
