I'm taking a break from my usual recap of SEL activities to share a suggestion. Please monitor your child's usage of all technology. Messages sent using technology (including phones, Ipads, gaming consoles, etc.) often spillover to school and can have negative effects. I also strongly encourage you to set time limits for your child's technology use. The brain needs a chance to rest and recover to be ready for school the next day. Setting up parental controls for every digital device your child has access to (both at your home and other homes where your child spends time) is equally critical. 
