The coin jars in the classrooms are filling up with donations for Seedlings. Thank you for supporting this effort! K Prep through Grade 3 continue to work hard on managing big feelings. Students are learning Second Step's 3 steps to calming down: 1) Stop, 2) Name your feeling & 3) Calm down (pick a strategy like belly breathing, counting, etc.). Practicing this at home can increase student's ability to do this in a "real life" situation at school. Another helpful thing to practice at home is waiting. Being able to wait is an essential skill for school (and life). It can lead to less interrupting, better focus and more positive behavior outcomes. 4th grade practiced how to learn other's points of view. 5th grade worked on a solution for the problem they have identified in their community. 6th grade worked in small teams to prepare for their service opportunity at Villa Marie.

The bin will be emptied daily.

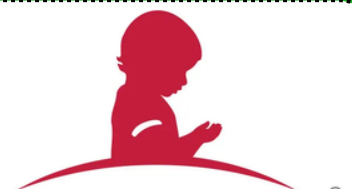
